

NITROGEN DIOXIDE

Nitrogen Dioxide (NO₂) is a toxic gas mixed with nitrogen and oxygen in a group of related gases called nitrogen oxides. **Nitrogen Dioxide** is a **red/orange, pungent, and highly reactive** gas formed from the burning of fossil fuels. Examples of fossil fuels related to NO₂ are coal, oil, gas, or diesel burned at high temperatures; the main source of emission is diesel-powered vehicles.

NO₂ exposure concentrations are of particular concern for susceptible individuals, including asthmatics, children, and the elderly
